Safety for Camper Travel

Important Times to Consider

Camp Kanuga is located within a 30-minute drive from the Asheville Regional Airport and a 1 hour 12 minute drive from Greenville/Spartanburg Airport. Please take this time into consideration when booking your flight.

Campers are not permitted to be at the camp prior to 3:00pm on Opening Day. The gates open at 3:00pm on the first day of your session. Campers may arrive later in the evening if necessary.

Safety for Camper Travel

Before travel talk to your children about:

- Strangers
- Using seatbelts on vans, buses and airplanes
- Identifying the Kanuga Staff designated pick-up (dressed in a green Kanuga Staff shirt)

Kanuga travel safety rules

- Campers must be sitting down
- Campers must wear a seatbelt
- One camper to a seatbelt
- Noise should be kept down so the driver is not distracted
- Do not throw things
- Only enter/leave the vehicle under direction of a staff member

- We will allow only licensed drivers to escort campers and will obey all North Carolina laws.
