Preparing for Camp: Missing Home

As you begin to plan for camp with your children, we are confident that you recognize the unique position campers are in moving from a virtual and socially distanced world into the incredibly social experience

that is camp. This year at summer camp across the country is going to be like none other, and we hope you'll be intentional with your children as you plan to leave them in our care. Even if your camper has been to camp many times, consider the past year as you plan with them to return to Camp Kanuga!

Below, you'll find an incredible resource about preparing your child for camp this summer. A couple of highlights that are really important to your child's experience at Camp Kanuga:

-Missing Home is Normal! We all miss home when we're away for a long time. You have and so have I. That is no different for children

Safety Testing: Upon Arrival

As I hope you've read within our COVID safety plan, we will be testing Residential Overnight Campers upon arrival at Camp Kanuga for by contracting with Wolfe Inc and Keystone Labs. They will use the shallow nasopharyngeal swab, and each test for Residential Overnight Camp will be Lab based PCR tests. (Starter Campers will receive rapid tests provided by the State of North Carolina.)

Each family will need to register in advance for your camper to receive this test. A comprehensive checklist will be sent next week, but the first step for check-in will be to register for your test. You are welcome to do that as early as possible. The Registration Form is below.

You may forego the COVID test upon arrival if:

-You have had and recovered from COVID in the past 90 days.

-You are a Starter Camper

-You have been vaccinated with the COVID vaccine.

Please note that Check-in will be different this year. Full check-in instructions will be sent next week in Volume 3!
